Notice in John 14:15, 21, 23, "If ye love me, keep my commandments... He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me, and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. Jesus answered, and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words, and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him." 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Faith Harvest Fellowship moves to Main Street

Faith Harvest Fellowship, a spirit-filled, full-gospel church birthed in Rockcastle County a little over two and a half years ago, has moved to a new location.

After some renovation, the congregation moved to the Community House, located at 60 Main Street in downtown Mt. Vernon. Dr. Michael Bryant, Sr. is the senior pastor. His two sons, Michael II and Matthew, are associate pastors at the church.

"Faith Harvest Fellowship's theme is 'Loving God and Loving People,'" Pastor Mike, Sr. says that the fusion God gave for starting the church was one of "stepping into the gap to reach people in our county and region who have not been reached."

He further said that "it is in our heart to bridge with and fellowship with the other churches in our area, as well as enhancing their ministries." He went on to say that "our purpose is to reach the lost and disciple believers." All people are welcome at Faith Harvest, including those who struggle with drug and alcohol problems, those who have been in jail, and those who are experiencing other kinds of negative issues in their lives.

The church has received much favor from the Lord and from the community during its short history. They have seen a number of people saved, filled, healed and delivered.

Another ministry of Faith Harvest is the Upper Room Counseling Services. This Christian counseling offers help for marriage, family relationships, parenting, anger management, anxiety, depression, grief and loss, fear, addictions, financial matters and premarital guidance. All three pastors are available to counsel individuals, couples and families.

Dr. Bryant has a vast experience of forty years of ministry, as well as numerous years of social work and law enforcement experience. Pastor Michael II and Pastor Matt also bring expertise to this service from their
