### Infants Who Stop Breathing-SIDS

Infants Who Stop Breathing—SIDS
Prisented by Dr. Kimberly Cornelius
Nothing is more trightening than having your baby stop boathing.
Sudden taftent Death Syndrome, or SIDS, is the unexpected death of an infant without other Illnesses.
Who are the children at risk? The three main groups of infants who have an increased risk of apnea (lack of breathing) are premature infants, sib-lings of infants who faced of SIDS, and infants who have been found breathless but were resiscitated.
Several other problems may cause an infant to have pauses in his breathing lasting over 15 seconds but are not necessarily associated with SIDS.
These include seizures, anemia, lack of development of the brain, and many other tillnesses.
Any baby who has had a period of apnea resulting in the skin turning blue or a slowing of the heart rate needs to be evaluated. This is often done by a 24-hour recording of the respiratory rate and heart rate to check for any abnormalities. 
