Sign-up for 2004 Direct and Counter Cyclical Program Warden Alexander, County Ex-ceutive Director, of Rockeastle to inform producers that the enroll-ment for the 2004 Direct and Counter-cyclical Program (DCP) be-Counter-cyclical Program (DCP) began October 1, 2003 beginning the second year of successful implementation of the 2002 Farm Bill.

Producers must sign DCP con-tracts annually beginning with the 2003 crop year, which is a change from Production Flexibility Contract requirements under the previous farm

Producers have until June 1, 2204 enroll for the 2004 DCP. Producers receive direct payments at rates established by statute regardless of market prices. Counter-cyclical pay-ment rates, on the other hand, vary

Livestock Assistance Program.
Rockeastle County has been added to the counties as being approved for the Livestock Assistance Program for the 2001 crop year.
Signup has been extended thru November 21, 2007.
To be eligible for LPA the county must have suffered at least a 40 percent grazing loss for three or more consecutive months in a calendar year. A producer may receive a LPA — hand basis of eli-

consecutive months in a catenoar year. A producer may receive a LAP payment on a per head basis of eli-gible livestock when the producer has control of adequate grazing land to support the eligible livestock. Eli-gible livestock include; beef and dairy cattle, buffalo, beefalo, sheep, goats, swine and other certain equine animals.

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To qualify, a livestock producer must have suffered a 40 percent or greater loss of grazing production for three or more consecutive months (April 1 thm June 30, 2001) due to drought, to tweather, disease, insect infestation, flood, fire, hurricane, carthquake, severe storm or other natural disaster. Lap payments will be reduced by the amount of assis-tance received by that produce un-der previous Livestock compensation Programs (LCP-1, LCP-1) and the 2002 Cattle Feed Program. A prooer previous Livestock compensation.

Programs (LCP-I, LCP-II) and the 2002 Cattle Feed Program. A producer must possess beneficial and financial interests in eligible livestock that have been owned or leased for at least three months.

A \$40,000 payment limitation also applies for IAP assistance.
