Library Board has three new members

Last Monday December 8th 2003, the Rockcastle County library board and staff enjoyed a holiday dinner together. Before the dinner the board met and said farewell to Mr. H. Allen Penzol for his dedicated service over the past several years as the library board chairman, also he said goodbye to Ms. Serena Stewart who had served for years as secretary. Certificates were handed out to Mr. Penzol, Ms. Serena and also Ms. Sue Hamm who had served on the board previously as vice chair. Books were given to the library in honor of their service on the board. County Judge Executive Buzz Carlolis swore in the new board members, Ms. Rebecca Isaacs, Mr. Steve McKinney, and Ms. Cloia Collins. The new members will serve with remaining board members Corey Craig who is the Treasurer, and Mr. Jerry Burke the Technology Consultant.

Ms. Rebecca Isaacs will serve as the new Rockcastle County Library Board of Trustee Chairperson. Ms. Isaacs is also the Title I Coordinator and District Supervisor for Rockcastle County Schools. As District Literacy Contact, Rebecca shares her knowledge, skill, and enthusiasm for the library's mission of providing information and reading materials from various categories with the community. 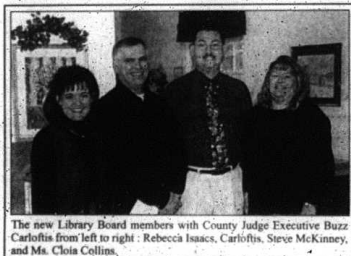
