This facility has been cited for
multiple deficiencies including:

FAILURE to give residents proper treatment to prevent new bed (pressure) sores or heal existing bed sores.^[2/11/2010]

FAILURE to develop and implement policies for screening and training employees; and the prevention, identification, investigation, and reporting of any abuse, neglect, mistreatment and misappropriation of property.^[10/18/2012]

FAILURE to ensure that each resident who enters the nursing home without a catheter is not given a catheter, unless medically necessary, and that incontinent patients receive proper services to prevent urinary tract infections and restore normal bladder functions.^[5/04/2011]

FAILURE to have a program that investigates, controls and keeps infection from spreading.^[11/02/2011, 5/21/2010]

FAILURE to ensure services provided by the nursing facility meet professional standards of quality.^[8/26/2010, 2/11/2010]

FAILURE to provide care by qualified persons according to each resident's written plan of care.^[8/26/2010]

FAILURE to provide necessary care and services to maintain or improve the highest well being of each resident.^[8/26/2010]

FAILURE to give each resident enough fluids to keep them healthy and prevent dehydration.^[2/11/2010]

FAILURE to provide housekeeping and maintenance services.^[5/21/2010]

FAILURE to properly care for residents needing special services, including: injections, colostomy, ureostomy, ileostomy, tracheostomy care, tracheal suctioning, respiratory care, foot care, and prostheses.^[8/26/2010]

FAILURE to conduct initial and periodic assessments of each resident's functional capacity.^[2/11/2010]

FAILURE to develop a complete care plan that meets all the resident's needs, with timetables and actions that can be measured.^[2/11/2010]

FAILURE to immediately tell the resident, the resident's doctor, and a family member of situations (injury/decline/room, etc.) that affect the resident.^[8/26/2010]

FAILURE to store, cook, and serve food in a safe and clean way.^[8/26/2010]

FAILURE to maintain drug records and properly mark/label drugs and other similar products according to accepted professional standards.^[8/26/2010]

FAILURE to ensure that a nursing home area is free from accident hazards and provide adequate supervision to prevent avoidable accidents.^[8/26/2010]

FAILURE to make sure that the facility is administered in an acceptable way that maintains the well-being of each resident.^[2/11/2010]

FAILURE to set up an ongoing quality assessment and assurance group to review quality deficiencies quarterly, and develop corrective plans of action.^[2/11/2010]
