Interested parties are hereby notified that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) wrote a Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed Rockcastle County Emergency Operations Center (EOC), to be on Progress Drive, in Rockcastle County Business Park South, Mt. Vernon, Rockcastle Co., KY. This Proposed Action's activities would include site clearing, grading; constructing a 5,000 sq. ft. building, cell tower, road, and parking area; installing site utilities (electricity, telephone, water, and sewer); and EOC operations and maintenance. Per the National Environmental Policies Act (42 U.S.C. 4371 et seq.), associated environmental laws, and FEMA's NEPA regulations (44 CFR Part 10), FEMA wrote a Draft EA to evaluate the Proposed Action and alternatives. The Public Comment period for this project ends 7 days after the date of this Public Notice. Public comments may be faxed to FEMA's Region IV Office at 770-220-5440; emailed to FEMA-R4EHP@dhs.gov" FEMA-R4EHP@dhs.gov; or mailed to William Straw, FEMA R4 REO, 3003 Chamblee Tucker Road, Atlanta, GA 30341-4112. Based on FEMA's findings to date, we expect no significant adverse effects on the natural or human environment. If new information changes these findings, then FEMA would issue a 2nd Public Notice for more comments. If no substantive, negative comments are received, then the Draft EA and associated Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) will become final and this 1st Public Notice will serve as Final Public Notice. FEMA will appropriately address substantive comments in final documents.

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
