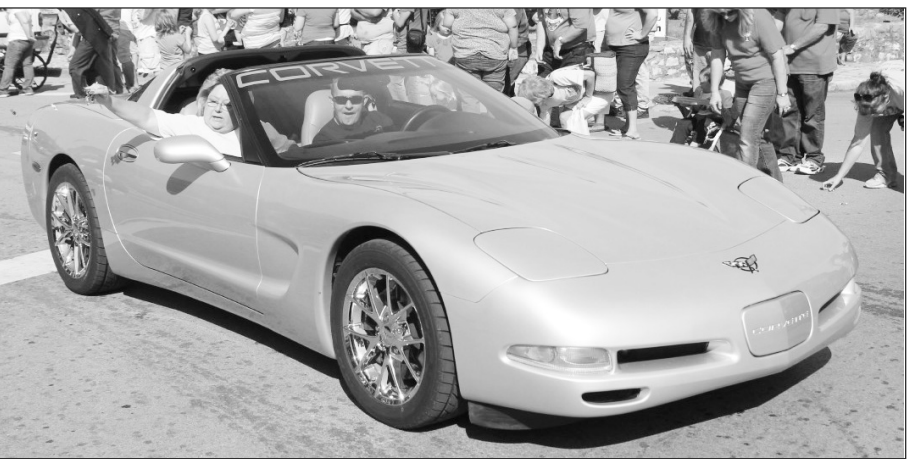




Circuit Court Clerk Eliza York waved to the crowd and passed out candy to the children during the parade.
