


Eighth grader Noah Prickett outruns a Foley defender for a touchdown during last Thursday night's 24-6 Rocket win for the conference championship





"The team played great. We executed on offense and made plays on defense," Parkey said. "We actually played just like we have been playing for the past two or three games. The only difference in this game was the scoreboard."

Parkey went on to say that

all the seniors had a tremendous game and that they rose to the occasion knowing it was the last time they would play in front of a home

"Harper and Hughes did a great job of catching the football. Benge, Kirby and Lake held the line of scrimmage on both sides of the ball," Parkey said. "Blaine Amyx contributed on special teams, Jones had the best game of his career and McPhetridge was on target all night leading our offense. I couldn't be happier with each senior's performance."

"They will pressure the line of scrimmage with six to seven players to get our offense out of rhythm. We need to stay patient with our running game and use our pass game to loosen them up if we want to come out with a win."
